C. Remembrance Day – Sunday 14 November 2021

This year's Remembrance Day Parade at the Cenotaph will take place on Sunday 14 November 2021.

Applications recently re-opened for a period of time and we now have 139 people registered to march at the Cenotaph this year. Tickets will be issued in October and distributed to those that registered or emailed if an address was provided with your registration.

Please note that if you did not register and plan to travel on the day anyway, you may not gain entry to Horse Guards Parade and Whitehall.

Successful grants are issued swiftly back to the caseworker for onward payment. Urgent grants can be made on the day if required. This process is both confidential and transparent, providing an audit trail.

G. Pangbourne Memorial Garden

A plaque to commemorate those that were lost during the Falklands War in 1982 was recently installed at the Pangbourne Memorial Garden. An annual Tri-Service event is held in Pangbourne to commemorate this.





H. Guards Para Memorial Dedication

The dedication of The Guards Para Association Memorial (Guardsmen of the Sky) will take place at the National Memorial Arboretum (NMA) on Friday 8 October 2021 at 1200 and will be conducted by Canon Alan Hughes. The founder of the GPA, Major General Sir Robert Corbett KCVO CB will carry out the unveiling. There will be a full dedication service lasting about 40 minutes, supported by the band of The Coldstream Guards.

The event will be supported by senior Household Division personnel, and Regt Lt Cols and COs. The Colonel Commandant of The Parachute Regiment the President of the SAS Association, CO 3 PARA and 6 (Gds) PI (subject to their FOE) will also be invited.

I. City of Liverpool Freedom Roll of Associations - Liverpool Branch

I am delighted to inform you that the Liverpool Branch of The Parachute Regimental Association has been added to the list of organisations and institutions of the City of Liverpool Freedom Roll of Associations.

The Honorary Freedom of the City of Liverpool can be traced back to the beginning of the 13th Century when Burgesses enjoyed equal trading rights and the exemption of certain dues and customs. However, since 1835, elected municipal councils meant that freemen were stripped of practically all of their privileges.

The Honorary Freedom of a Borough Act of 1885 empowered local authorities to confer the Honorary freedom upon persons of distinction who have rendered eminent service to the city or borough. However, this made no provision for organisations and institutions to be similarly honoured.

In March 1991, Liverpool City Council created the Freedom of Roll Association and Institutions to include organisations who had a long and significant connection with the city, like the Honorary Freedom of Liverpool, it is the highest honour the City can bestow. Armed forces are granted Freedom Right of Entry of the City of Liverpool and the right on all ceremonial occasions of exercising the privilege by marching "with Colours flying, drums beating and bayonets fixed" if applicable.

This honour was granted to the Liverpool Branch of The Parachute Regimental Association at the beginning of 2020. Sadly, due to the pandemic, the presentation of the scrolls has been delayed until the 24 Oct 21 and instead of the Town Hall it will be given at Liverpool Parish Church, this is because again due to Covid and the Town Hall has a very large back-log of activities to clear.

Congratulations to the Liverpool Branch on achieving this status.
